Alliances (NATO, CSTO)

- Cold War: bipolar order, institutionally divided
- UN and Bretton Woods: power and hegemony
- ▶ Two Trends Since 1945: institutions and powers

- Trend 1: institutional growth and diversification
- **Examples: NATO, AU, OSCE, CSTO, SCO, OPCW...**
- > Trend 2: from bipolar to unbalanced tripolar to...
- Great Powers: US, RU, CH, and maybe IN
- After Cold War: no dispersion, oligarchic system

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MULTILATERAL CRISIS AND GREAT POWERS

- Multilateralism current crisis
- Cause 1: MIs lack of effectiveness
- Cause 2: fictious capital and social conflict
- Cause 3: blocked democratizing pressures
- The Trump factor

- US Grand Strategy after Cold War
- World Order: Unipolar and Globalized
- Since 2001: ABM withdrawal and UNSCR 1973
- Pax Americana as Revisionist and Offensive push
- Trump: paroxysm of Paris Agreement and "Trade War"

- China Grand Strategy after 1979
- Self-Strengthening Reforms
- Asia Pacific Area of Influence
- ▶ To avoid clashing with US
- Since 2012: "striving for achievement"
- Multilateral: SCO, APSCO, ASEAN+, AIIB, BRICS...
- China+N platforms and BRI as a global process

- Scale: global (oceans and outer space?)
- Interaction Capacity: hypersonic and digital
- ▶ Kapital: asianization, concentration, six fold GDP
- Macht: regional states, terrorism, major war risk
- Knowledge: diffusion, exponential growth, Al
