

CLIMATE & SECURITY




CLIMATE

- Global Warming: 97% scientific agreement NASA
- IPCC 1.5° C Report: 45% greenhouse reduction
- UNFCCC 2018: 17 SDGs mitigation / adaptation
- Sea levels, extreme weather, ecosystems . . .
- Anthropocene and Gaia: catastrophe w/o cataclysm
- Trump versus Global Climate Governance



SECURITY

- Being able to neutralize discernible threats
- Threat: intent to inflict harm, pain, or loss
- Violence as Kratos (structural and actual power)
- Climate + Security: wrongful or intentional ?
- From vulnerability and sensitivity to conflict ...
- Direct cause: natural resource scarcity
- Indirect: institutional failure and multiplier



VIOLENCE

"THE INTENTIONAL USE OF PHYSICAL FORCE OR POWER, THREATENED OR ACTUAL, AGAINST ONESELF, ANOTHER PERSON, OR AGAINST A GROUP OR COMMUNITY, WHICH EITHER RESULTS IN OR HAS A HIGH LIKELIHOOD OF RESULTING IN INJURY, DEATH, PSYCHOLOGICAL HARM, MALDEVELOPMENT, OR DEPRIVATION."

AMAZON

BASICS ARE HUGE

- Amazon basin: 6,3 million km² (35.5% of South America)
- **Europe:** 10,2 million km² (Portugal to the Urals)
- 20% of world's water carried by rivers
- Seven countries: BO, BR, CO, GY, PE, SU, and VE
- Amazon rainforest: 5,5 million km² (1/3 world's largest)
- 67 % within Brazil, 13% in Peru, 10% in Colombia
- Largest biodiversity, 20% of water, 10% of carbon stores




SUSTAINABLE ? DEVELOPMENT ?

- Brazilian Amazon: 09 states (forest, cerrado, pantanal)
- **5.2 million km²**, 61% of the Brazilian territory
- 24 million people, 12.3% of the Brazilian population
- 300 + thousand indigenous people (817 thousand total)
- Deforestation: down 72% under PT, up since 2016
- **Bolsonaro:** socially and environmentally unsustainable
- Amazon 2016: 48 rural leaders killed, 391 assaulted



HUNI-KUIN & SHIPIBO-CONIBO

PANO LANGUAGES





HUNI-KUIN (KAXINAWÁ)

- Hantxa Kuin language, Pano family
- AC 10,818 (2014) / PE 2,419
- AC: 35 (TI), 19 thousand, 209 villages, 14.5% of AC
- Rivers Tarauacá, Jordão, Breu, Muru, Envira, Humaitá, Purus
- Violent conflicts from 1913 with rubber bosses' mateiros
- Since Measels epidemics, health attention major issue
- 2017 Jordão flood: 15 families displaced, official neglect
- 2019 Open Letter: recognize climate-security nexus
- Envira river: Huni Kuin and Shanenawa threatened by narcos



SHIPIBO-CONIBO

- Shipiba language, Pano family
- + 26,419 population estimated (2014), 8% of indigenous PE
- Shipibo and Konibo formerly two groups, merged
- Ucayali river, more than 140 communities
- Some groups in urban areas, like Pucallpa or even Lima
- Since the rubber economic cycle, conflicts and threats
- Severe pressure form oil companies, logging, and narco
- Constitution recognizes Peru as multi-ethnic, UNDRIP 2007
- From droughts to floods, food insecurity and weak institutions



CONCLUSION

- Unequal effects of climate change
- Vulnerability + Institutional Failure = Insecurity
- Indigenous most vulnerable in the Amazon
- Mitigation matters: Huni-Kuni (2017) Shipibo (2011)
- Indigenous peoples: climate change + SDG 2030
- Inter)Government responses: FUNAI, AC, OTCA
- Macro Politics: from wrongful to intentional
- Trump and Bolsonaro as threats to Gaia and humans
